1. Div. III, Cl. 4-0. 25 Any. Enamels. Specialized to modern enamel buttons. No limit on studio buttons, identify artist if known. Include an example from each pictorial section. \$15-10-5.

## **Editor's Award**

2. Div. IX, Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24. 24 Any. Pictorials assorted, specialized to nouns that start with the letters E-D-I-T-O-R. Proper nouns and open compound nouns acceptable. (Ex. "Theodore" and "Ice cream"). Four buttons for each letter. Limited to 5 realistic and 5 studio buttons. \$10-6-4.

## **Chairman of Competition Award**

3. Div. IX, Cl. 1-0 thru 15-5. 25 Any. The Three Amigos. Assorted Materials specialized to pictorial buttons with subjects in groups of 3 (ex. 3 birds, 3 dogs, 3 baskets, 3 boats). No limit on studios or realistics. \$10-6-4.

## **Jacksonian Memorial Pictorial Award**

4. Div. IX, Cl. 17 - 2. 20 Any. Birds Assorted. Try for a balance of the sub-classes. Label bird. No stylized birds. Jacksonian Button Club, in honor of all members past and present. \$60, \$40, \$20, plus Jacksonian button to 1st place winner.

## **Sidonia DeAngelis Memorial Award**

5. Div. III, Cl. 14-1.2. 25 Any. Burwood, Syroco. \$10, \$7, \$3. Mayflower Button Club.

6. Div. I, Cl. 7-4.13 + 7-4.14 + 7-6.3.2. 42 Small. Paperweights, radiants, and kaleidoscopes. 14 of each. Carol Danhauser. \$5-3-2.

7. Div. I, Cl. 7-7.9. 25 Small. Victorian glass specialized to 10 white, 10 colored, and 5 free choice. In honor of Montgomery Smith for all she does for MBS and the National Society. LeRue Werner. \$10-7-3.

8. Div. I, Cl. 11-4 + 11-7. 20 Large. Shell specialized to decorative finishes and OME. Christy Mecey. \$10-5-3.

Armor, Fashion accessories, and Unlisted objects related to fashion or objects that would enhance fashion (i.e. clothing, jewelry, armor, feathers, etc.).
